It has been estimated that 200,000 people in India are annually diagnosed with organ failure, needing transplantation the life-saving measure.

Organ that can be transplanted are heart, liver, kidneys, lungs, pancreas and intestine. Tissues which can be donated and transplanted are heart, liver, kidneys, lungs, pancreas, intestine heart valves, corneas, bones marrow, tendons, middle ear and skin.

Organ donors can be anyone living or deceased (cadaveric donors) of which the organ can be transplanted to the patient urgently require.



Orbital Lymphangiomas are rarely seen in elderly patients. We report a rarest of rare case of an orbital Lymphangioma in a 75-year old patient with a chorioretinal fold involving the macula causing distortion of vision.

Dry eye syndrome is an inflammatory disease of tears and ocular surface and patients with ocular rosacea frequently suffer from dry eye. Artificial tear supplements, the most commonly prescribed therapy for dry eye provides temporary and incomplete relief and do not alter the pathophysiology of dry eye i.e. ocular surface inflammation. A prospective, interventional, randomized, double-masked, placebo-controlled, multi-centric study has revealed that dietary consumption of Omega 3 fatty acids for six months significantly improves dry eye symptoms in patients with Rosacea along with skin disease.
